Cox Orange Pippin	Braeburn, Northern Spy, Yellow Delicious	mid Sept to Mid Oct	Medium size, red stripes over smooth orange skin. Firm yet tender juicy flesh. Excellent for eating & cooking. Semi Dwarf
Ginger Gold	Cox Orange Pippin, Honeycrisp, Red McIntosh	Mid to late August	Semi dwarf. Mild flavour with tart finish. Great for pies
Gravenstein	Braeburn, Cox's Orange Pippin, Northern Spy, Red McIntosh, Yellow Delicious, Yellow Transparent	August	Excellent flavor. Deep yellow skin with red stripes. Great eating and dessert apple. Semi Dwarf
Honeycrisp	McIntosh, Braeburn, Gala, Granny Smith	late Sept	Big red, crisp,& juicy. Stores well. Semi Dwarf
Jonagold	Braeburn, Cox's Orange Pippin, Northern Spy, Red McIntosh, Yellow Delicious, Yellow Transparent	mid to late Sept.	Medium sized red eating apple with green markings. Crisp, juicy, sweet-tart flesh. Stores well. Semi Dwarf
King	Cox Orange Pippin, Honeycrisp, Red McIntosh	Mid to late Oct	Semi dwarf. Large, waxy yellow with red striping. Crisp & sweet
Melrose	Cox Orange Pippin, Ginger Gold, Honeycrisp	late Oct.	Medium to large, red apple, aromatic. Excellent for storage. Bears heavily. Cross between Jonathan and Delicious. Semi Dwarf
Mutsu	Braeburn, Cox's Orange Pippin, Northern Spy, Red McIntosh, Yellow Delicious, Yellow Transparent	late Oct.	Very large, round, yellow-green apple. Crisp and juicy, tart. Great for fresh eating and in desserts. Stores well. Semi Dwarf
Red Delicious	Braeburn, Spartan, Fujii, Golden Delicious, Granny Smith	late Sept	Big red dessert apple. Dwarf
Red McIntosh	Braeburn, Cox's Orange Pippin, Northern Spy, Red McIntosh, Yellow Delicious, Yellow Transparent	mid Sept. - mid Oct.	Medium to large bright red fruit. White tender flesh. Tart, spicy flavor. Great for fresh eating, cooking, or aromatic cider. Heavy producer. Semi Dwarf
Yellow Transparent	Braeburn, Cox's Orange Pippin, Northern Spy, Red McIntosh, Yellow Delicious, Yellow Transparent	early July-early Aug.	Medium to large fruit with pale yellow skin. Crisp, very sweet flesh is ideal for pies, scauce, and fresh eating. Heavy producer. Dwarf
Apple trees like full sun, well-drained soil with medium fertility and slightly on the acid side.

Lapin	Self, Bing, Montmorency, Van	mid July	Dark red, crack resistant. Great taste, suitable for eating, baking or preserves. Dwarf
Stella	Self fertile	early July	Medium sweet fruit. Dwarf
Sweet cherry trees like full sun and a deep, well drained loam soil. Wet, poorly drained soil must be avoided.			

PLUM	POLLENIZERS	HARVEST	DESCRIPTION
Brooks	Self fertile	early September	Semi dwarf. Early Italian strain, purple
French Prune	Everything here except themselves and Italian Prune	late season	Small to medium, red/black. Sweet. Good for canning and drying. Semi Dwarf
Italian Prune	Self, Green Gage	Aug. - Sept.	Medium size, purplish black skin. Sweet. Excellent for eating, canning and drying. Semi Dwarf
Satsuma Plum	Everything here except themselves and Italian Prune	mid season	Medium, dark red, solid meaty flavour, sweet. Semi Dwarf
Plum trees like full sun and a well-drained, slightly acid soil containing plenty of organic matter.

Comice	Bartlett, Anjou, Bosc	Sept.	Large, thick skinned fruit. Improves with 1-2 months cold storage. Creamy texture. Semi Dwarf+D19
Flemish Beauty	Bartlett, Anjou, Bosc	September	Medium to large clear yellow fruit, firm flavorful flesh. Good quality for eating fresh or canning. Very hardy. Semi Dwarf
Pear trees like full sun and a finely textured soil with good drainage.
